SITE:

Our 2019 Reserve Merlot was farmed at Lost Horn Vineyard in Okanagan Falls, South Rock Vineyard on the Golden Mile Bench, and Lazy River Vineyard in South Cawston. These vineyards were planted in 1990, 1993, and 1998 respectively.

NOTES & PAIRING:

This wine highlights the various terroirs from the South Okanagan and Similkameen Valleys, imparting mocha, black currant, and tobacco flavours. The finish is long and plush with dark fruit, oak spice, and a savoury, herbaceous note.
