Our Pinot Noir vines were planted in the mid 1990s at our Lazy River Vineyard in South Cawston, Similkameen Valley. This dramatic rugged river valley brings out distinct earthy and mineral characteristics that we absolutely love.

NOTES:

This medium-bodied wine shows classic notes of fresh and vibrant black cherry, cranberry compote, and subtle spice. A fantastic match for poultry, West Coast salmon, or tomato-based pasta dishes.
