SITE:

Our Rosé is a co-fermented field blend from our estate vineyard in West Kelowna which was planted between 1996 and 2002. This site sits directly beneath the dormant volcano that is Mt. Boucherie.

NOTES & PAIRINGS:

A mouthwatering Rosé with aromas and flavours of watermelon, strawberry, and spice. From our coolest site in West Kelowna, this wine is framed by orange flavoured acidity and pairs wonderfully with charcuterie, summer salads, and nice views.

Varietals: Field Blend - Pinot Noir, Gewürztraminer, Zweigelt.

Appellation: Okanagan Valley, British Columbia

Cellar: Spontaneously fermented from wild yeasts after soaking on the skins for 6 hours

Harvested: October, 2021
