Our fondness for all things Alsace and double entendres is alive and well. Elder vicar refers to our own Father Pandosy (the first chap to plant wine grapes in BC), but is also a riff on the Alsatian wine known as "Edelzwicker" meaning noble blend of Pinot Gris, Riesling, Gewürztraminer, and Muscat.

"Clos St. Hune" in Alsace - Our homage to one of the most iconic vineyards in Alsace, which has been making wine in this style since 1626.

Father Pandosy was the first
European settler in the Okanagan. He noted that the land appeared fertile and bounteous and planted the first vines in the region to provide a little tipple for the sacrament.

Flower - always meant to have a nice perfume! A co-fermented Muscat, Riesling, Pinot Gris and Gewürztraminer. The (wild) fermentation stopped a little earlier this year, resulting in an off-dry style.

Honey Bee shaped architecture from our home.

The Similkameen Valley - Lazy River Vineyard - home of the grapes within the bottle.
