la graves is a region on the left bank of bordeaux, producing the best examples of sauvignon/sémillon blends in the world. we 'robbed' this style and made it our own here in BC. it also translates to gravel which our lost horn vineyard is riddled with. born on the left bank. raised in the westbank.
