Sourced from Mt. Boucherie's vineyards in South Cawston, the Golden Mile Bench, and Okanagan Falls, The Boss is blended from five select barrels collaboratively chosen by winemaker Jeff Hundertmark and the wine directors of Save-On Foods.

NOTES:

A wine filled with rich aromas and flavours of cassis, dark fruit, cedar, and silky complexity. A superb addition to any cellar, The Boss will reward those with patience, ageing elegantly over the next decade.
